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● Immunohistologic techniques can determine the presence of keratin, which is seen in epithelial tumors; vimentin, which is associated with fibrohistiocytic tumors, pigmented nevi, melanomas, hemangiomas, and lymphomas; or desmin, which is noted in leiomyocytic tumors.

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• Of 601 consecutive private patients, 2.5% were found to have lesions with the clinical appearance of congenital nevi (1.5 to 19.9 cm in diameter). Nevi spili were present in 2.3%, and 13.8% had café au lait spots.

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
