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- Of 48 thin (≤ 1 mm) melanomas studied, 11 had definite and 13 had probable evidence of histologic regression, which was defined as the presence of one or more segments within a lesion where there is marked reduction of malignant melanocytes in the dermis. After a median of 90 months of follow-up, none of these 24 lesions had recurred or metastasized.
